HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS; GRADUATION CEREMONIES

The Board of Trustees, in partnership with parents and the community, is committed to ensuring that every student graduates college and career ready. The Board values developing graduates who are lifelong learners, productive workers, responsible citizens and thoughtful participants in our diverse community. The Board will ensure students are provided a high quality learner centered education aligned with the District's Strategic Plan and the requirements set forth by the Nevada Department of Education that best prepares students for opportunities to be successful in their post K-12 experience, whether they choose additional formal education, the military, or immediate transition to the workforce.

The Board of Trustees shall award a high school diploma to every student enrolled in this District who fulfills the requirements set forth in Nevada Revised Statutes and by the Carson City School District.

The standards and procedures for participation in high school graduation ceremonies will be provided to all students at each high school and to their parents or guardians at the start of each school year.
