<u>HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) OR</u> <u>ACQUIRED IMMUNODEFICIENCY SYNDROME (AIDS)</u>

Pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the Carson City School District is responsible for providing an education for all students in the best possible setting. Federal law prohibits discrimination against students with HIV/AIDS if they attend schools which receive federal funding. When the District is informed that a student has HIV/AIDS, education will be provided in an appropriate setting based on a review of the student's age, behavior, neurological development, physical condition and the health and safety of others.
