## PARTICIPATION OF HOME-SCHOOL/PRIVATE SCHOOL/CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS IN CARSON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT PROGRAMS

- 1. The Board recognized its obligation to allow students of charter schools, home schools and private schools within the District to participate in certain sports and extra-curricular programs offered by the District. The District shall provide by Regulation, the procedures and requirements of such participation.
- 2. Home schooling, charter schools and private schools are alternative education programs for parents of students who do not wish to have their students enrolled in a comprehensive public school. Home schooling is a means by which students are exempted from compulsory education while receiving instruction at home. Charter and private schools are institutions of learning that offer various educational opportunities with a unique structure and purpose. Periodically, parents of home-schooled, charter-schooled and private-schooled students request the participation of their student in sports and other extra-curricular activities, such as choir, band and a variety of academic areas not available at home, charter or private schools. These students may participate in such programs upon the terms and conditions as shall be provided by Regulation.
