



What does Pioneer High School (online) Look Like?
What is the parent/guardian seeking? What are you used to?

ONLINE FORMATS: Parents/Guardians can request one of the 3 options, but the Pioneer Online School team may adjust the student's schedule based on performance and academic needs.

- 1. PHASE 1: Independent Online Schedule: Minimum Standard (Requires the most support at home from parent/guardian) This schedule uses Apex curriculum and is supported with a CCSD teacher with mixed grade levels. This format will use self-paced asynchronous lessons. It requires more support from parents/guardians, more student self-discipline, and ability to be independent for students to be successful.
- 2. PHASE 2: Mixture of Full Remote and Independent Schedule: (Possible format with staffing information) This format is a mixture of some independent lessons with Apex software and some full remote subjects with a CCSD teacher online.
- 3. **PHASE 3: Full Remote Online Schedule:** (Staffing will Determine) This is accomplished with a CCSD teacher using CCSD curriculum. This schedule mirrors the daily class schedule at a brick and mortar school.

ONLINE HIGH SCHOOL DAILY SCHEDULE

- Teacher Availability: Full Time Online Teachers & Mixed Grade Level Teachers
 - o Teaching time occurs between 7:30am-2:15pm, M-F.
 - o Email/Phone calls will be answered to families within 24 hours on school days.

o Teacher office hours occur each day for parent conferences and will be advertised.

PHASE 1

INDEPENDENT ONLINE SCHEDULE: (This is the Known Format)

- Apex curriculum and mixed grade support by a CCSD teacher
- Mandatory check in times daily
- Teacher/Student and Teacher/Parent/Guardian time will be available
- 5 days at 6 hours or 30 hours per week
- HS students will take 4-7 courses at a time
- Teachers makes contact with student/guardian as needed, interventions based on performance
- Interventions such as one on one support, teacher contact, tutoring, small groupings will be used
- CCSD teachers available for in person conferences
- All online work will be done off campus, testing will be done at the PHS campus for high school only
- Parents sign a contract to support their students 2-5 hours per week

PHASE 2:

This format is not guaranteed but will be a goal as we grow and staffing is determined Possible Full Remote or Mixed Schedule
